He showed them where to hunt and fish, how to build long houses and how to plant local crops.

In the spring of 1621, the harvest was great. The thankful pilgrims invited Squanto and his tribe to a great feast to thank God and them for their survival. The celebration lasted for 3 days and that was the very first Thanksgiving !
